CHRIST'S CALL

Being called by Christ, then, means personally dying and rising as Christ did, and it means doing it every day. Being called by Christ also means sharing with others our experience of the freeing presence of God. Through Christ, God has entered into our personal lives, into our own suffering. Answering the call of Christ means doing no less for others.

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER – 2010

On Friday, March 5, 2010 at 2:00 p.m., we are invited to pray with Christians around the world with the theme, “*Let Everything That Has Breath Praise God!*” Our neighbors at Hope Lutheran Church, 30 Shaftsbury Drive will host. This year’s service is prepared by women of Cameroon. This country, located in the centre of Africa above the equator, has a striking variety of landscapes and is well known for its styles of music, particularly makossa and bikutsi. We pray for change in Cameroon’s human rights issues which include violence, torture, and unnecessary force often used by the government to quell political dissent. We pray for fair distribution of antiretroviral drugs for the treatment of HIV/AIDS, which is often siphoned from government hospitals and hoarded in private quarters or auctioned on the streets.
